In-Depth Local Forecast for CLINTON

Today we will see mostly cloudy skies with a 35% chance of showers and thunderstorms, high of 80°, humidity of 60%. South wind 8 mph. The record high for today is 93° set in 1899. Expect mostly cloudy skies tonight with a 55% chance of showers and thunderstorms, overnight low of 62°. South wind 8 to 11 mph. The record low for tonight is 24° set in 1909. Sunday, skies will be mostly cloudy with a 65% chance of showers, high of 72°, humidity of 58%. West southwest wind 10 to 13 mph. Sunday night, skies will be partly cloudy, overnight low of 47°.
